## BCCG ORGANISATION

BCCG is a privately-funded non-profit making membership network organisation, which was founded in Cologne in 1919 and in Hamburg in 1921. It had been closed down in the early 1930s and was re-established in Cologne/Bonn in 1960. HM Ambassador to Germany is honorary patron of the chamber.

Members of the chamber comprise 1,000 professionals and companies, of which approx. 11 % enjoy the special status Sustaining Membership (see next page for details). In addition to that, a number of members (up to the age of 40) have joined our Young BCCG programme. The network consists of over 4,000 personal addressees and we also maintain contact with our members in all European British Chambers through our membership in the COBCOE, the Chamber's umbrella organisation. The BCCG is the largest British Chamber in Europe.
