

# Your only Airport actually located in London



The trade between Germany and the UK is consequential. The volume of air travel between the 2 countries reflects the trend: 14.6m passengers in 2017 (up 22% since 2012).

London City Airport has had longstanding links with Germany – connecting London with major cities for both trade and tourism with British Airways, Lufthansa and Flybe serving Frankfurt, Berlin and Düsseldorf and a new three-times-a-day Munich from February 2019. Frankfurt is consistently a top 10 route with 9 daily flights for London City Airport (c.250K passengers per year).

London City Airport is the only airport actually located in London. Our punctuality is the best in the UK and our passengers love our convenience. We are based in East London within travel zone 3. It takes only 11 minutes by public transport to reach

Canary Wharf, 21 minutes to Bank and 30 minutes to the West-End.

A transformational £500 million development is underway to create a world-class gateway. It will deliver a completely new airport experience including 8 new aircraft stands, a parallel taxiway, and an expanded terminal approximately 4-times in size. Upon completion in 2022, the airport will be able to accommodate 6.5 million passengers, welcoming the next generation of quieter, more fuel efficient aircraft.
